In Review

2011 was an exciting year for Highland Counseling Center! One year ago there were 12 counselors at HCC. Collectively we were providing support to approximately 75 clients. Today, we have 28 counselors and are providing support to approximately 225 clients! Our collective capacity for client caseload is now closer to 475!

While our ability to provide professional support to the Denver Metro Area has increased, it remains to be said that we are only covering a very small fraction of the mental health needs of our community. In the past month alone there were 22,000 people that typed via their Internet search engine, the keywords, "Denver Therapy," in search of a counselor. About 500 of those searches led to the Highland Counseling Center website. In the past month, there were approximately 85 referrals to counselors at HCC. The bottom line: While we are progressing rapidly, WE CAN STILL DO MORE!

I could not be happier about the progress made at HCC and more importantly, the community that has been created. I am excited about 2012: increasing visibility, reputation, and support offered to the Denver Metro Area.

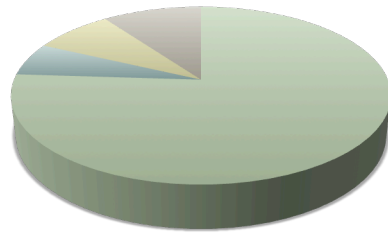

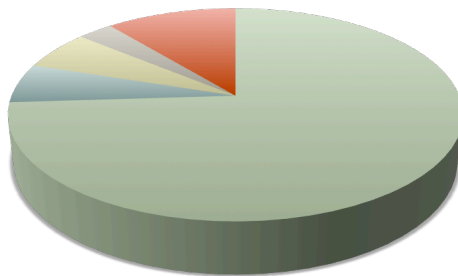

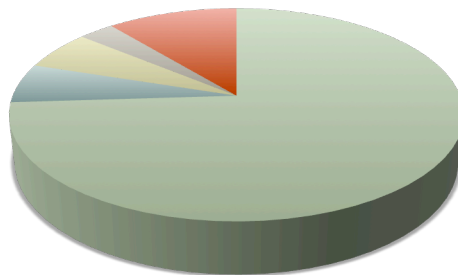
